Dear Early Childhood Education Center Families,

The safety of our children is our top priority at the ECEC. This message is to let you know that the Salt River Fire Department and an ambulance were called to the ECEC today after a child sustained an injury in their classroom. Due to federal privacy laws, we are not allowed to disclose more information; however, the ambulance did transport the child, and we are expecting the child will make a full recovery and return to campus soon.

Some children may come home today and want to talk about the fire truck and/or ambulance, or about the injury their classmate experienced. Just like teachers do in classrooms, we encourage families to talk with young children about emergency responders, the importance of taking care of our bodies, and what to do if we get injured.
